Directions to DRWA Administration & Training Facility

210 Vickers Drive
Milford, DE 19963

From North (SR 1):

Take SR 1 south to first exit for Milford/US 113. Go south on 113 to light at Milford Bowling Lanes. Turn right onto Airport Road. Travel west on Airport Road 7/10 mile to Greater Milford Industrial Park on the left (Hickman Overhead Door Company will be on the corner). Turn left onto Hickman Door Way. At the end of the street, turn right onto Mullet Run. Travel west on Mullet Run which will become Vickers Drive after it curves around to the left. Turn right into the parking lot.

From South (SR 1):

North on SR 1 to turn for Milford High School (NE 10th Street). Go 7/10 mile to second light at intersection with US 113. Cross over 113 (the road becomes Airport Road). Follow the directions above.

From North (Rt. 13):

South on US 13 to Route 15 at Canterbury. Turn left onto 15 (also known as Canterbury Road) and travel south on 15, crossing over Midstate Road (4-way stop with blinking light, also known as Route 12) and go 2.4 miles to intersection with Carpenter Bridge Road. Cross over Carpenter Bridge Road; travel 4 miles and make a left onto Airport Road. Go 3/10 mile and turn right onto Brent-Jordan Way. Go to stop sign and turn right onto Mullet Run which will become Vickers Drive after it curves around to the left. Turn right into parking lot.

From South (Rt. 13):

North on Rt. 13 to light at Harrington (intersection with Route 14; Hardees on your left). Turn right onto Route 14 (Milford-Harrington Highway). Make a left onto Route 15 (Canterbury Road) then a right onto Airport Road. Follow directions above.

ASSE NATIONAL BACKFLOW PREVENTION ASSEMBLY TESTER CERTIFICATION

DATE: April 23-27 *or* June 25-29 *or* October 22-26, 2012

TIME: 8:00 A.M.—5:00 P.M. Daily, 40 Hours Total

COST: \$795/person

Course prerequisite: You must have 5 years documented experience in the field of plumbing, pipefitting, water/wastewater distribution or collection or another related industry field.

This course is designed to train participants in the intricacies of field testing of backflow prevention assemblies. Backflow prevention assemblies included are: pressure vacuum breakers, spill proof vacuum breakers, double check valve assemblies and the reduced pressure backflow preventer assemblies, (RP). This training course will be composed of a series of lectures followed by guided exercises in a wet lab where "hands-on" activities and experience will provide an understanding of the proper field testing methods for backflow prevention assemblies. The necessary tools, test gauges and other equipment are provided for use in the wet lab sessions. There will be plenty of backflow prevention assemblies, tools and gauges available for the students to practice on during the wet lab practice times of the course. Upon completion of this course and the written and individual performance tests where each participant must demonstrate his or her ability on each assembly the participant will be issued an "ASSE Certificate of Completion" and an "ASSE Tester Certification Card" and an "ASSE Tester Certification Number" from the American Society of Sanitary Engineering. The certification card and number will allow participants to test backflow prevention assemblies in any jurisdiction where ASSE Certification is accepted and the State of Delaware. **Class Size: Min-12, Max-16**

RE-CERTIFICATION OF ASSE NATIONAL BACKFLOW PREVENTION ASSEMBLY TESTER

DATE: June 28 *or* October 25, 2012

TIME: 4:30 P.M.—10:00 P.M.

COST: \$425/person

Course prerequisite: Proof of current/valid ASSE certification is required.

This course is for individuals currently holding an ASSE Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester certification but whose certification is due to expire. Assembly testers must hold a valid certification for three years from the date of initial certification and/or recertification. Recertification will be awarded after successful completion of a hands-on lab test (RP and DC) and a 25-question written exam. The exam will consist of a written portion (1-hour time limit) and a hands-on evaluation (1-hour time limit). All exams are closed book.

Upon successful completion of both the written and hands-on exam, the student will be awarded a three, (3) year National ASSE Certification in Backflow Prevention Assembly Testing.
